Reminders...

GREENHILLS

RE-SCHOOL

Easter holidays to minimise any disruptions to kinder session times. Committee will continue to apply for more grants through the year to help us complete this project.

We were blessed when we had a change in weather for the best at our welcome picnic. It was nice to see everyone and their families enjoying each others company while sharing a meal. Educator's Report

Welcome to Greenhills Preschool 2016

We believe the staggered starts at the beginning of the year have allowed us, parents and the children to interact in a very calm and relaxed atmosphere as we begin our kinder journey into 2016. As we head into the term, our kinder friends are starting to become familiar with kinder routines, new faces, and names. This will create a very strong foundation, which will assist the children to develop a sense of belonging and security in their kinder environment.

Growling Grass Frog Group

The children have been very involved in various small group dramatic role play experiences, such as Police Officer & Hospital role play.



Sensory play has also been very popular, with children experimenting with sand, water and dirt. They have been creating potions, mud slides and "swamps". Please remember to pack a spare set of clothes in your child's kinder bag so they can change out of their wet clothes.

At our meeting times we have been involved in discussions with children about how to be safe at kinder, what it means to be a good friend, and our personal space bubble. We have also implemented the "Who is here today?" board, where children sign into kinder each day they arrive by placing their photo on the board. This is helping the children understand who they will see on each kinder day, and also creates a sense of belonging to our kinder community.



Swift Parrot Program

The Swift Parrots have moved into full sessions and have been very busy. There has been lots of play, but also many new things to learn about being at kinder – arrival routine, snack time, cleaning up and meeting time. We are delighted at how well they are coping with all of this change, and are enjoying getting to know them better.

A few birthdays have already been celebrated and the children enjoyed using the special birthday 'bits' to create their offering to the birthday child. 'Happy Birthday' has been sung with gusto each time.

Timers have become a natural part of play now, when using the swing. They really help with the difficult concept of taking turns and sharing.







Healthy eating at Greenhills

In our 'Nutrition and Active Play' policy, we encourage families not to pack 'sometimes' foods for snack time, and to provide *water only* in reusable drink bottles. What is 'Sometimes' food? 'Sometimes' foods are often called 'treats' – things such as biscuits, cakes, desserts, potato chips, pastries, fried and takeaway foods, soft drinks and confectionary. They often contain lots of sugar, fat or salt and should only be eaten in small amounts.

We also encourage the packing of nude free snacks/lunch for your children. This is a rubbish free snack in a reusable container (i.e. sandwich wrap, yoghurt pouch) or Mother Earth's compostable containers (i.e. banana). A great way to purchase these items and support kinder is through 'Litter free living' who have great products – please see the flyer attached at the end of this newsletter for more information.

Over half the families at kinder were able to come along last Thursday night for our 'Welcome Picnic'.
