#### **Educators Report**

#### **Growling Grass Frogs**

Can you believe we are in the midst of Term 4? Such an exciting time for all our kinder friends as they consolidate their time at kinder and look forward to new adventures ahead. Swift Parrot friends look forward to going to "big kinder" and Growling Grass Frog friends begin their journey to school. Our kinder friends have started visiting their nominated schools and have begun their orientation programs. Transition and Learning Development Statements have been sent home to all GGF families. Reminder to all Growling Grass Frog Families: please complete the family and child section of the statement and return to kinder by Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> November.

In our Kinder program, we help children "know about school" through the following strategies:

- Provide school uniforms in our dress up area to encourage children to role play and act out school scenarios
- Invite school students to kinder to interact with our kinder friends and talk about school
- Read stories and have discussions about school
- We will visit Greenhills Primary school to provide children the experience of a school environment (where children can find out about and see the playground, classrooms, and toilets and learn about the routines of school). Invite other local schools / teachers to kinder.
- Help advertise any school orientation dates for families to access

#### **Educator's Report**

#### **Swift Parrots**

We were so happy to see all of our kinder friends after our holidays. The children are a very sociable and busy group and readily involve themselves in play with others at every opportunity. It is wonderful to see the collaboration between the children growing as they play. They are blossoming and growing up so quickly. They are growing physically, becoming more vocal, adventurous and confident. This is very evident during our visits to the reserve.

#### Reserve visits

As you know we have quickly moved to long sessions in the reserve, which the children are really enjoying. We have been taking magnifying glasses, binoculars and most recently small boards with paper and pencils. The children have asked to have more of these so we



will be investing in some more of these resources. The interest in bugs and insects is growing which we will be building upon. The parachute and games such as 'What's the time Mr. Wolf?' are favourites and work well in the larger space. Please sign up to attend our reserve visits held every second Thursday on the sheet near the sign in book.

#### **Excursion to Edendale**

On Tuesday 5th December we will be spending our kinder session at Edendale Farm in Eltham. The children will be doing two of the educational programs offered that we feel fit into our program: Eltham Copper Butterfly – we will learn about this endangered species that lives on our back door in detail using drama. Environmental art – the children will create a print on a calico bag using fresh flowers and foliage.

We will be meeting and farewelling you and the children from the farm. Please put this in your diary and if you are able to come along we will be calling for helpers when we send more details closer to the date.



#### Favourite book bag

We have introduced the 'Favourite book bag' to the group. Each child will have a turn (chosen randomly) to bring in their favourite book for us to read to the group. This is an intentional part of our program to foster the love of reading and connections with family and the children's confidence in speaking to their peers. We will ask questions to try and find out what the name of the book is before revealing and reading the 'secret' book.
