Educator's Report

Swift Parrots

We have enjoyed a wonderful year of learning and growth with our Swift Parrots in 2019. It has been such a pleasure over the year to see children gain confidence to separate from family and begin to form new relationships with peers and staff. Children have gained many independence skills, social skills and lots of confidence to explore the kinder environment.





On Thursday 28th November, Ethan's mum Vinci visited us at kinder. Vinci works as a dietician and came along to share her special skills with us and read a story about a superhero eating a 'rainbow' of fruit and vegetables. We then each had a turn picking a card from the mystery bag and each card had a different coloured fruit or vegetable. Our friends were all keen to share their like/dislike of certain foods and the ones they had tried at home. We matched the colour to the rainbow and learned about the nutritional value of different fruits and vegetables. Vinci brought along a rainbow fruit/veggie colour chart to encourage eating a variety of fruit and vegetables every day.
