Our first two sessions of Term 3 have begun slowly with less of our friends attending due to lockdown. Hopefully we will be able to return back to kinder soon as we have missed seeing our friends' smiling faces.

A big thank you to Graham (Celeste's dad) for helping us secure our mud pit water tank. Our Swift Parrots had a wonderful session collecting water to use in the mud kitchen. Please remember to bring gum boots and a change of clothes for your child each session. We have a large basket outdoors to store gumboots if you would prefer to leave them at kinder.



We would like to extend a warm welcome to William and Jude who have joined our Swift Parrot group. We are looking forward to sharing lots of fun and learning experiences at kinder with you both.



Our friends are continuing to take turns with our kinder Honey Bear

at home. We have enjoyed sharing their experiences and seeing photos of family members too.

We will shortly be introducing our Swift Parrots to the kinder fire pit. Each year around Father's Day, we are very lucky to participate in a special celebration and lantern night at kinder. During lantern night our Greenhills families gather in the evening and walk together around the reserve perimeter with lanterns which the children have decorated.

In preparation for our lantern night we discuss ideas and experiences with fire and include risk and safety aspects. In the sandpit Roseanne and Carol start a small fire (in a wok) using leaves, branches and twigs that the children have collected. Our Swift Parrots sit around

# *Educator's Report* Growling Grass Frogs

In dealing with lock down #5 we have implemented discussions with the children about dealing with frustration and disappointment. Having to recently postpone our dental visits and Melbourne museum incursion, delay our visits to the reserve, put Coach Phil on hold, and not have all our friends attend kinder has proved challenging (not to mention all the changes that children and families have had to deal with at home, such as cancelling birthday parties, family events etc). We believe providing space for children to talk about their feelings helps not only validate how they are feeling, but provides children with an understanding that we are "all in this together." While we always help develop children's emotional vocabulary, it is especially important in the current COVID climate. We are pleased to collaborate with a local coffee roaster, Love Is Coffee to bring everyone freshly roasted coffee using certified organic, fair trade coffee beans.

There are 4 varieties - Ethiopian, Nicaraguan, Guatemala and Columbian. They come in 250g bags, with the options of whole or ground, and can be ground to your preference (espresso/plunger). Each bag costs \$10, a special price for Greenhills Kinder families and friends (r.r.p. \$12.50). The kinder will earn \$3.50 for every bag sold.

This is a great opportunity to:

- raise funds for the kinder
- support a small local business
- indulge in some retail therapy to get us through lockdown,

all of which are great reasons to grab ourselves a bag or two!

## Health Reminder

Please be aware that it is important to keep children at home when unwell. Our COVID safety plan states that we must exclude from kinder:

Any staff, child or visitor who has a temperature over 37.5 degrees

Any staff, child or visitor who indicates any of the following:

- Fever
- Chills or sweats
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- Runny nose
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- In certain circumstances headache, muscle soreness, stuffy nose, nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea may also be considered symptoms of COVID 19.

Children should not attend kinder, even if they have the mildest symptoms. Or if they are indeed unwell. Please remember to inform Educators if your child has undertaken a COVID test and please email the test results to: greenhills@ecms.org.au

# **Chia Pudding**

- 2 tablespoon chia seeds
- 1/2 cup milk (coconut milk,cows milk)
- 1 teaspoon honey/maple syrup or other sweetener, optional
- 1 teaspoon vanilla essence
- Strawberries or other fruits for topping

# Instructions

• Pour ingredients into a jar and mix well. Let settle for 2-3 minutes then mix again very well until you see no clumping.



- Cover the jar and store in fridge overnight or for at least 2 hours.
- When you're ready to eat it, top with your favorite fruit and enjoy cold!
- (Can also be made with cocoa for a chocolate pudding!)
