## Educator's Report

A very warm welcome to our 2022 children and families. We are filled with excitement and anticipation about all of the growth and wonderful learning experiences that we will share with you throughout the year at Greenhills Preschool.

We believe play is an intrinsic tool that children use to become active, passionate learners who enjoy gaining knowledge and information by discovery, investigation and invention, in their own way and at their own pace. The very best way to give children what they need, is an environment that is interesting to explore, that is safe, and is filled with people who will respond and support the child's emotional needs.



Our first few weeks of kinder are all about learning lots of new things: routines, snack time, wearing a hat outside, and lots more. We are encouraging children to use our hat stand to house their kinder hat for easier access (and to help prevent lost hats)! Each child has a labelled hat bucket where they can keep their hat. If you are happy to leave your child's hat at kinder that would be great, then you always know they have a sunhat to wear whilst playing outside during their kinder sessions.

Life at kinder has been so busy already, with so many new things to play with and areas to explore. It has been great to watch the interactions between kinder peers begin to develop. The children have enjoyed gathering outside to picnic, meeting our stick insects, creating in the studio and working in the sandpit.





#### General Reminders to all our Greenhills Families

- Please have your children arrive at kinder with sunscreen on as well as a sun hat throughout the term.
- Ensure that you sign your child in and out as this is a legal requirement.
- All items need to be labelled with your child's name to help with items becoming lost or muddled with other children's belongings.
- Please provide a family photo for our photo board you can email one through to greenhills@ecms.org.au and we can print one out to display
- Remember to pack "healthy" food options for your child to eat at kinder some ideas include sandwich, wrap, fruit, yoghurt, crackers, cheese, dip, sushi, popcorn, vegetable sticks
- We ask that you please refrain from packing nut- based foods in your child's snack box. We have an anaphylactic child enrolled at Greenhills Preschool this year who have severe nut allergies
- As children may be involved in messy play, it is advised they wear old clothes to kinder, and have a change of clothing.
- Remember to check your child's pocket for kinder, social & fundraising information and your child's artwork.
- If you are going to be late at pick up time please call the kinder to inform Educators on 9434 3379.



## **Blueberry and Banana muffins**

#### Description

These deliciously sweet Blueberry Banana Muffins will be a breakfast or morning tea favourite. They are heavenly to eat warm, straight from the oven but also are lovely packed into lunchboxes or for a grab and go snack. These are a simple one bowl recipe that comes together in no time at all.

#### **Ingredients**

- One (150g) large overripe banana mashed
- 1/2 cup (125ml) extra virgin olive oil
- 1/2 cup (125g) Greek yogurt
- 2 eggs
- 1/3 cup (55g) packed brown sugar
- 1/3 cup (80ml) maple syrup
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 2 cups (250g) wholemeal flour
- 1/2 cup (55g) rolled oats (and extra for sprinkling)
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 200g blueberries



#### Method

- Preheat your oven to 180c and grease and line your muffin tin
- In a large bowl add in the banana, olive oil, greek yogurt, eggs, sugar, maple syrup, vanilla and cinnamon and whisk together until well combined
- Add in the flour, oats, baking powder, baking soda and the blueberries and stir through until just combined
- Spoon the mixture evenly between the muffin cups and sprinkle with oats
- Bake in the oven for 15 minutes or until a skewer inserted into the centre of the muffin comes out clean

## Lunar New year - Chinese Lantern Sun Catcher



#### You will Need:

Paper Black Texta Scissors Red Cellophane Contact paper

#### Instructions:

1. Parent/Gaurdian draw a lantern on using black texta, be sure to leave plenty of space for cellophane. Then cut out the lantern around the black texta.



2. Parent/ Guardian then cuts red cellophane into small pieces and places the Chinese lantern on a piece of contact paper.



3. Your child can now have fun carefully placing pieces of cellophane into the gaps. When they have filled all the spaces, place another piece of contact paper over it to seal it.



4. Cut around the lantern to remove any extra pieces. Hang in the window to catch the sun.
